➤ **Closing Statements**

- Trustee Dugan commented that he received a notice of water restrictions and that he didn't understand why we were on restriction when we had so much rain. Mayor Jeroloman explained a few years back the Town was given notice by the DEC that they must come into compliance on the DEC mandate. The mandate is that you must be able to supply the same water rate to all well heads if the highest producing well head goes down. The Town could not meet requirements so they looked for alternate water source. A water source was found by Orange and Rockland. The water would need to be brought down rte. 208; this would cost an estimated one million dollars. Currently this would cost about two million dollars. After talking with the Village Engineer Jim Farr the Village Board will have to go out to bid for the job. Mayor Jeroloman also stated they would meet with Senator Larkin to find out if any funding was available for the project. Trustee Mullany stated that the Board was committed to getting the water to fix the problem.

➤ **Public General Comments**

- Resident Lorraine Tomassi questioned the Board as to when she can burn again. Mayor Jeroloman responded that he wrote a letter to the state and he has not received notification from them yet. He explained the ruling goes by density and if the State responds "no" then we will have to go to a bagging system.

➤ **Executive Session**

- Board entered into executive session at 8:00 pm- motioned by John Hickey seconded by Dorine Sas with Attorney regarding pending and future litigation.
