- Moshe Halpern, Kingsville Drive is in support of the sewer addition, it brings revenue.
- Linda Gagliardi, Bailie Lane advised that she is paying a substantial sum every quarter for sewer as per the developer's agreement.
- Steve, Dallas Drive advised that the Sleep Inn is a good asset to the community.
- John Salka, Woodard Drive is in favor of the petition and asked what the difference is between in district and out of district. He added that the Hotel is wonderful.
- Bonnie Rum, Lake Shore Drive now understands that the petitioned sewer is already included in the County Sewer calculations.
- For the record Mr. Gagliardi and Attorney McKay clarified that the pump station is private and will not be dedicated to the Village.
