PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE ON PROPOSED LOCAL LAW

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the Village Board of Trustees of the Village of South Blooming Grove will hold a public hearing on a proposed Local Law creating a new Chapter of the Village Code entitled “Removal of Double Utility Poles”, requiring utility companies to remove inactive, damaged, unnecessary or replaced utility poles within the Village.

The meeting will be held on Tuesday, October 15, 2019 at 7:01 p.m. at the South Blooming Grove Village Hall, located at 811 State Route 208, Monroe, New York 10950, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard.

The Village Board of Trustees will hear all persons interested in the subject of the proposed local law at the above time and place, including any comments with respect to the potential adverse environmental impacts of the adoption of the local law in accordance with the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act (“SEQRA”). Public participation will be limited to 3 minutes for each individual.

Anyone wishing to supply written comments can do so by submitting or mailing the same to Village Hall, P.O. Box 295, Blooming Grove, New York 10914, so as to be received by noon on the date of the Public Hearing.

The Village of South Blooming Grove will make every effort to assure that the hearing is accessible to persons with disabilities. Anyone requiring special assistance should contact the Village Clerk.
