- The Village Clerk read the public hearing notice regarding the Tentative 2018 Village General Fund, Water District and Sewer District Budgets.

➤ **Correspondence**

- Village Accountant Marvin Nyman presented the proposed budget to the board and the public. Contractual expenses with the town have incurred small increase in budget. An additional part time building inspector has been added to the town. Capital projects fund accounts for the majority of the budget increase to allocate for highway projects that will need to be addressed. Discussion ensued regarding the cell tower property that is currently rented through the village. BAN will be needed for capital expenses for water and sewer projects that are to be completed in 2018.
- Mr. Nyman then presented the water budget and offered that the purchase of new water meters is included in the increase for 2018. A new meter reader will be purchased from Sensus for the upcoming year. There are no significant increases in the water budget.
