#### Mayor Comments

 Mayor Jeroloman briefed residents about fire that took place June 29, 2017 at a vacant structure located on Lake Anne property. Fire was brought under control in a timely manner and the incident is under investigation.

#### **Public Comments**

- o Erin McAvoy resident inquired about the Michael Court school bus accident that occurred in June 2017. Mayor Jeroloman gave report regarding the ongoing investigation; child was taken to the hospital, bus recorder has been taken for evidence. Quality Bus has been contacted regarding safety procedures and whether charges have been filed has not been determined at this time. Resident inquired about the Town of Blooming Grove law regarding short term rentals. Final version is in process of being presented; upon receipt process of enforcement will be determined.
- o John Salka, inquired if the driver of the Quality Bus was given an alcohol exam at the time of the accident. Mayor responded that Police Department was conducting the investigation and has followed protocol required for school bus accidents; will follow up with the Police Chief and report findings.

- Vicki Codner expressed concerns about speeding and parking on Merriewold Lane South.
  Mayor stated the town engineer has been contacted regarding how the issue can be addressed.
- SueAnn Vogelsberg mentioned 245 Prospect Road property maintenance has not been addressed; grass has not been cut. Property owner has been issued violations, building inspector in process of determining if property has been abandoned. Public hearing is scheduled for July 17, 2017.
- o Steve Kearins request for status on removal of SeaLand container located at 9 Dallas Drive. The property owner has been issued a court appearance date to have the container removed. Inquired about law regarding fences obstructing vision, public hearing is scheduled for July 24 regarding the village fence law.
- o Erin McEvoy resident asked is there a time limit for dumpsters; the Mayor stated that if there is a building permit, a dumpster is permitted. Length of time that permit is open will be established to address the issue of how long a dumpster can remain at a property.
- O John Salka inquired if there is a law not permitting the disposal of household garbage in dumpsters. Stated that dumpsters are for renovation materials and that household garbage will attract rodents and should not be permitted in any dumpster.
- o Brian Bohan inquired if there is public presentation regarding the Town of North Monroe. Further information for public will be disclosed at meeting scheduled to take place in August. Process regarding a public referendum will be forthcoming after information is provided to the village board. Suggestion given that residents contact local legislators for information.
- o Eric Vogelsberg commented that it appears that a new exit ramp is being installed on Route 17. At present the village does not have information regarding the new exit ramp.
